

**HARRIS COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE**

March 21, 2011

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submit, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2009 ESG Funding:

Project 2011-0061 Catholic Charities Basic Needs Services Program - obligate \$33,835.00 in 2009 ESG Homeless Prevention funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$33,835.00.

Project 2011-0062 Catholic Charities Villa Guadalupe Transitional Housing - obligate \$23,480.00 in 2009 ESG Op/Personnel Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$23,480.00.

Project 2011-0063 Houston Area Women's Center Domestic Violence Emergency Shelter - obligate \$21,787.00 in 2009 ESG Op/Personnel Funds, \$25,977.00 in 2010 ESG Op/Personnel Funds, \$5,061.00 in 2011 ESG Op/Personnel Funds and \$38,431.00 in 2011 ESG Essential Services Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$91,256.00.

Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$91,256.00.
