

**HARRIS COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE**

May 10, 2010

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submit, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2006 CDBG Funding:

Project 2009-0052 Neighborhood Centers Stay Connected Program - deobligate \$17,931.00 in 2006 CDBG Public Service Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$18,765.00.

2009 ESG Funding:

Project 2009-0040 Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Galveston-Houston - Guadalupe Center Family Assistance - deobligate \$10,172.13 in 2009 ESG funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$23,662.87.

Project 2009-0042 Harmony House Langston House - deobligate \$6,533.16 in 2009 ESG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$15,882.84.
