

**HARRIS COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE**

August 13, 2010

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submit, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2008 CDBG Funding:

Project 2008-0029 Harris County CSD Health & Safety Home Repair Program-Deobligate \$67,693.00 in 2008 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$172,307.00.

2009 CDBG Funding:

Project 2009-0029 Harris County CSD Health & Safety Home Repair Program-Deobligate \$206,000.00 in 2009 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$34,000.00.

Project 2009-0036 Harris County Public Library-McNair Branch Library-Obligate \$342,500.00 in 2009 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$833,760.00.

Project 2009-0012 Harris County CSD -Non Emergency Medical Transportation Program-Deobligate \$115,942.60 in 2009 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$184,056.40.

2010 CDBG Funding:

Project 2010-0031 Harris County CSD Minor Home Repair Program-Obligate \$400,000.00 in 2010 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$544,000.00.

Change in Scope:

Original Scope of Work- A total of 10 households will receive assistance from this program.

Revised Scope of Work- A total of 40 households will receive assistance from this program.
