

**HARRIS COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE**

August 26, 2013

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submit, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2013 HOME Funding:

Project C2013-0042 Tidwell Lakes Ranch, Ltd - Tidwell Lakes Ranch - Obligate \$1,918,282.00 in 2013 HOME Funds. Total project funding, will be \$1,918,282.00.

2012 HOME Funding:

Project 2012-0028 City of La Porte Northside Neighborhood Program 4 - Deobligate \$248,929.35 in 2010 HOME Funds and \$290,668.65 in 2012 HOME Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$380,402.00. *Scope Change:* This project proposed to develop and construct six single-family homes in two phases to assist low-income residents within Harris County, prior to project closeout the project's scope was revised to develop and construction of three single-family homes in one phase to assist low-income residents within Harris County.

2010 HOME Funding:

Project 2012-0028 City of La Porte Northside Neighborhood Program 4 - Deobligate \$248,929.35 in 2010 HOME Funds and \$290,668.65 in 2012 HOME Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$380,402.00. *Scope Change:* This project proposed to develop and construct six single-family homes in two phases to assist low-income residents within Harris County, prior to project closeout the project's scope was revised to develop and construction of three single-family homes in one phase to assist low-income residents within Harris County.
