Re: Revision to the 2016 Floods Method of Distribution

Harris County revises the allocation in the 2016 Floods Method of Distribution (MOD) regarding the line item for the City of Houston. The City has requested and been granted approval from the Texas General Land Office the ability to convert all of its 2016 Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) non-housing/infrastructure funding of \$13,159,931 to housing. The new housing allocation for the City is \$23,486,698.00. The City of Houston’s total CDBG-DR allocation remains \$23,486,698.00, there was no change to the total allocation.

All other allocations to the county and the cities of Jersey Village, Katy, Baytown, Humble, Tomball, and Pasadena under non-housing and housing are without change.
