

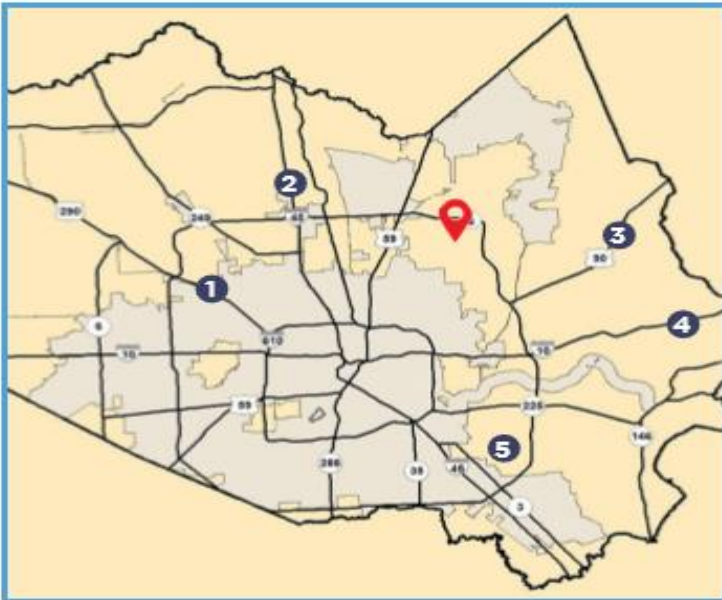
HARRIS COUNTY PROJECT RECOVERY-HARVEY BAYTOWN INTAKE CENTER PREPARES TO ACCEPT CLIENTS AT PERMANENT LOCATION

(HOUSTON) Residents of Baytown and East Harris County looking for assistance recovering from Hurricane Harvey have a new location where they can receive help applying to the Project Recovery-Harvey program, Harris County officials announced today.

The new location, at **729 Sharon Lane in Baytown**, opens its doors to the public on Monday, June 3, replacing an interim office located along Market Street. The Sharon Lane office will operate Monday – Friday from 8am – 6pm and on Saturdays by appointment only from 9am – 3pm. A limited number of appointments are available on Saturday, June 1. To schedule a Saturday appointment, please call 832-927-4961.

With the addition of the Baytown center, Project Recovery-Harvey now has five permanent locations to assist Harvey-affected homeowners who live in Harris County, but outside the Houston City Limits, get access to federal money designated to help repair flood-damaged homes, reconstruct homes deemed unlivable or vulnerable to future flooding, or for reimbursement of repairs already made.

Prior to visiting an Intake Center, residents are encouraged to fill out a pre-application at harrisrecovery.org. A list of the five Intake Centers, and their locations, is included in this release. Project Recovery-Harvey will also continue to operate a part-time mobile intake location in Sheldon on Tuesdays and Fridays from 8:30am to 5:30pm.
